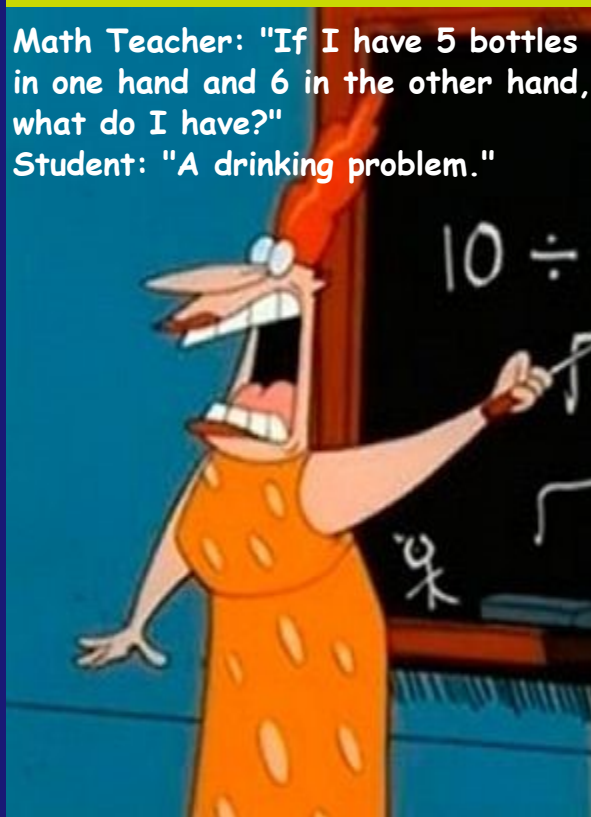

I look forward to seeing you soon during this wonderful season.

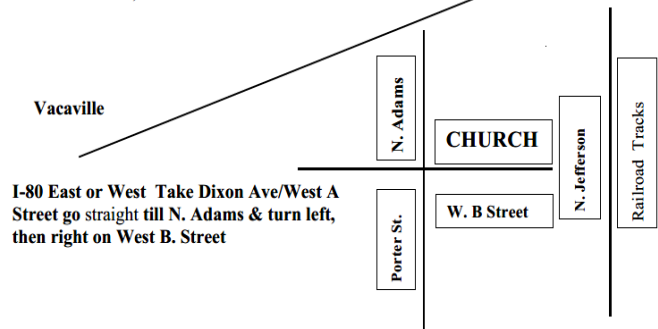
