Service work is a great way to keep your recovery strong!

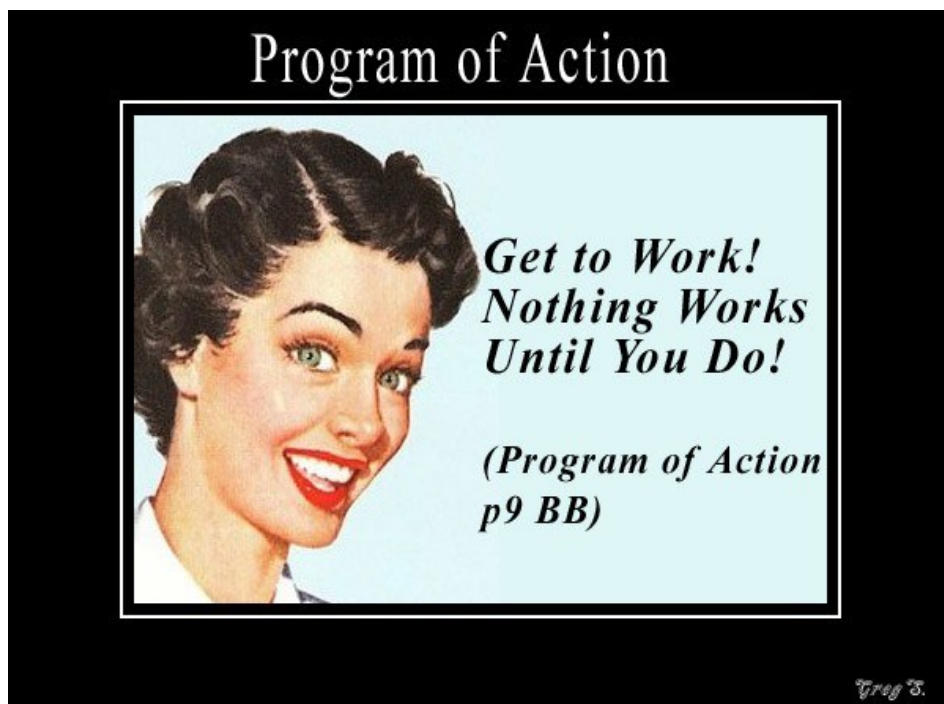
CHAIRPERSON'S MESSAGE (continued)

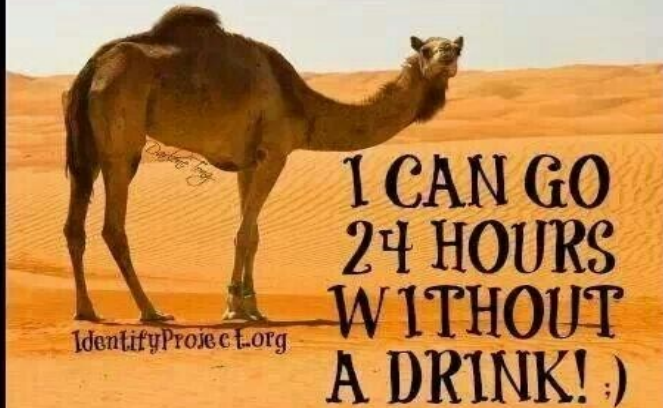
